1991

- Arbor Hospice expanded its programs and services to the Downriver community with the opening of a new branch office

1998

2000

- Agency formally changed its name to Arbor Hospice & Home Care
- Northville branch office opened to better serve the residents of western Wayne and Oakland Counties

2002

- Annual 'Art Dash' fundraising event first established in Northville benefiting Arbor Hospice & Home Care
- Annual Camp BraveHeart camping weekend first held for grieving children and families
- Formally established The Arbor Hospice Foundation to ensure the financial future of the agency

2003

- FYE 2003 marked the fourth consecutive year of positive financial results, with an average annual surplus of \$750,000.
- 12th Annual Arbor Hospice Chair*ity Affair benefiting Pathfinders Children's Program generated record fundraising

2004

- "Circle of Friends" Annual Giving Campaign launched
- BraveHeart Grief Services established to serve as key community resource for grieving children and families

2005

- Comprehensive clinical information system launched
- Debt reduced; bonds refinanced to achieve substantial interest rate reduction and interest cost savings
- Thomas Misko memorial golf outing held benefiting Arbor Hospice & Home Care in the Downriver community

2006

- Record hospice patient census of 224 patients achieved in October 2006; average annual patient census up over 60% from 2004
- Record annual revenue of \$13.5 million reached
